# \*\*\* 2023 Opening Day of Trout Season Information

### 2023 Opening Day of Trout - April 1st at 8:00am

#### Dave Haywood

February 20th - Fishing at the Club will be closed after this date and will resume on opening day of trout beginning on April 1st at 8:00am. Purchase your 2023 PA fishing license with a trout stamp prior to opening day

March 30th - We will stock 2,300 ~ 13- 14 inch rainbow trout

March 31st - We will stock  $2,300 \sim 13$ - 14 inch &  $25 \sim 20$ - 26 inch rainbow trout



April 1st - Opening Day of Trout ~ 8:00am.

April 7th - We will stock  $4,000 \sim 13$  - 14 inch & 25  $\sim$  20- 26 inch rainbow trout. (No fishing until 6:00am on April 8th)

April 14th - for Kid's Day - we will stock  $600 \sim 13$ - 14 & 12  $\sim 15$ - 17 inch rainbow trout in the kid's pond, pickerel pond, and catch and release pond. These ponds will be off-limits to all members until April 15th at 8:00am.

April 15th - Kid's Day-open to kids 12 years of age and under. Begins at 8:00am. Only one (1) rod can be used. The parent or guardian can throw the line in, but the kid must reel the fish in by themselves. There will be prizes, along with hotdogs and drinks this year.

April 16th - Members can fish in the kid's, pickerel, and catch and release ponds after 6:00am



ALL GUN RANGES and the ARCHERY RANGE WILL BE CLOSED FIRST TWO WEEKENDS OF TROUT SEASON -April 1st, April 2nd, April 8th, April 9th & Kid's Day on April 15th



















Members of the Board of Directors will man strategic check points the first two weekends of trout season verifying everyone's Club membership. You must have in your possession the following:

- 1). 2023 Club membership badge
- 2). 2023 PA fishing license with trout stamp
- 3). A valid photo ID

Anyone caught attempting to bring in a nonmember to fish will immediately lose their membership in the Club. No Exceptions.



All ranges will be closed the first two weeks of trout season (April 1st, 2nd, 8th, 9th) and for Kid's Day (April 15th).

We are currently shooting indoor bulls-eye and will begin the outdoor Wednesday night shoots in April. The Wednesday night outdoor shoots are open to all, but you must complete a safety check (new shooters) and non-members must sign a release and pay a small fee. Please clean up after yourself, including picking up empty shell casings and placing them in the buckets. Pick up any misfires and place them in the orange bucket. Please pull your staples and place target stands back where they belong. Do not shoot in front of the benches. Do not use the saw horses to hold targets. Eye and ear protection must be worn on the range. Be safe and courteous to others. Report bad actions to any one of the Directors immediately. This is your Club, please keep it safe.
