

The Game Committee would like to thank the youth pheasant hunt volunteers for their time and effort in spite of inclement weather.

In addition to PA Game regulations, the following rules apply when hunting on Club grounds:

- No single projectiles while hunting with firearms on Club grounds, hunting is limited to shotguns and archery equipment.
- Hunters must wear a fluorescent orange hat for all hunting on Club grounds; this is in addition to any fluorescent orange required by PA Game laws.
- Tree stands may not be left on Club property, and must be carried in and out each day.
- Hunters using tree stands are required to wear a full body harness while on Club property.

Please be advised a large portion of our recently purchased property is within safety zones. Safety Zone violations will not be tolerated and you are responsible for your actions on Club grounds.

Please hunt safely, and respect safety zones while on Club property.

We are now shooting out doors every Wednesday night (weather permitting) with a varied program. Center fire speed shooting, man- on- man center fire, .22 and pin shooting are some examples of what we offer participants. Every week we do something different. Skill levels vary greatly, so do not be worried about your possible performance. You must pass a safety check to in order to participate. Also, please be aware of signs and instructions on using the range. They are posted for your safety. If you do not know what a squib is, please look it up or ask someone. If you reload, do not exceed the maximum load as recommend for the powder and bullet weight since this is a safety issue. Please clean up your brass and put it in the brass buckets. Also clean up your trash. Please return the target stands to where they are stored and PULL your staples from the up rights. A basic pistol course is being held in May. This class is limited to 12 people. If there is enough interest, another class may be scheduled for June. Please e-mail me at a2quest4@msn.com if you are interested. Remember, safety first, have fun, and enjoy the summer.

Orange Hat / Vest Policy

A Florescent orange hat or vest is mandatory on the rifle range and while hunting. Not to supersede Pennsylvania Game Commission laws. Recommended, but not mandatory for all others. All Pennsylvania Game Commission laws apply.

A bell has been installed between trap #2 and #3. Anyone wishing to shoot trap from the manual trap during fishing season is required to ring the bell ten (10) minutes <u>prior to shooting</u>. Anyone fishing in a drop zone is required to move to a safe zone.

Lost & Found

If you have lost or misplaced any personal belongings while on Club property be sure to check the lost and found inside the Fisherman's cabin.


