

Waterfowl hunting is prohibited on Club grounds. The Club property lines have been posted to reflect any recent land acquisitions, in addition there are two large up to date maps in the Fisherman's cabin which show our property boundaries. Please respect neighboring land owners property lines and safety zones.

In addition to PA Game regulations, the following rules apply when hunting on Club grounds:

- No single projectiles while hunting with firearms on Club grounds, hunting is limited to shotguns and archery equipment.
- Hunters must wear a fluorescent orange hat for all hunting on Club grounds; this is in addition to any fluorescent orange required by PA Game laws.
- Tree stands may not be left on Club property, and must be carried in and out each
- Hunters using tree stands are required to wear a full body harness while on Club property.
- Baiting is not allowed on Club property

Safety Zone violations will not be tolerated and you are responsible for your actions on Club grounds. Please hunt safely, and respect safety zones while on Club property. A Florescent orange hat or vest is mandatory while hunting.



***** Notice To All Club Members *****

Membership cards must be displayed in full view at all times while on Club grounds at all times. Dependents using a copy must display it at all times. It is not to be hidden behind your fishing license, inside your tackle box, at home, in your car or in your wallet. You must also have a valid picture ID with you at all times. Members are responsible for the conduct of their dependents while on Club grounds.

Fishing

Bass season opens on June 8th and runs through September 30th. Bass must be at least 12' to keep them. Bass fishing size limits can be found on the PA State website www.fishandboat.com. The Club follows all the PA Fish and Boat seasons, sizes and creel limits.



There are two Fish-for-Free days this year, May 26th and July 4th. You do not need a license to fish on those two days, however, you must be a Club member.

Rifle

The .22 rimfire 200 yard league has begun. It's on the second Tuesdays of the month through October. Sign in is at 6:00pm and shooting starts at 6:30pm. Just a reminder that shotguns must be patterned on the patterning range by trap number 3 and not on the rifle range. Also fisherman please do not park in front of the rifle range. Park over by the wood piles. Remember to check out the rules on the website. It is your responsibility to know the rules. They are listed below. All shooters must sign in prior to shooting and sign out when done shooting. All members who are buying surplus ammo need to know what type it is. ARMOR PIERCING is prohibited. Please remember that all cameras are operational at all times. Thanks, Jake

Range Rules

Range Hours: Monday through Saturday 7:00am - sunset & Sunday 9:00am to sunset.

- 1). Never handle a firearm while people are down range period!!!! You will absolutely lose your membership!!!
 2). All firearms are to be unloaded and actions open while people are down range. Muzzleloaders will have the powder removed from the flash pan and primers removed from the nipple or breech plug.
- 3). Use the man down range sign even if you're the only one using the range.

4). Always wear a blaze orange hat/vest, eye and ear protection.

5). No armor piercing or penetrating ammo, No tracer ammo, No 50 BMG or 416 Barrett ammo, No full auto or bump firing 6). No patterning of shotguns. Use the patterning range by trap number 3.

7). Paper targets only. No exploding targets of any kind!!!

8) Targets are to be mounted on the horizontal boards provided. With bulls-eye between the upper and lower boards.

9). All shots are to be fired into the target impact areas.

- 10). All shooters must shoot into the target area in front of them. No shooting across the range!!!
- 11). No children on the range without an adult and <u>no</u> guests.



Any violations of the above rules could result in the loss of membership!

We are now shooting out doors every Wednesday night (weather permitting) with a varied program. The first Wednesday night of the month will be center fire pistol and pcc's. The second Wednesday of the month will be .22 pistol and rifle. The third Wednesday will be center fire pistol and pcc's. The fourth Wednesday will be tactical shotgun. If a fifth Wednesday occurs, it



could be any combo. All shooters are required to take a safety check prior to participating. These events are open to all members for at no charge and non-members will pay a fee. Please remember to clean up after you use the ranges and return items back to where they belong. Put empty cartages in the buckets provided. \$3.00 of each entry to form prize fund divided as follows: 6 prizes for the class shoot off; 1st High Overall, 2nd High Overall, and 1st High and 2nd High for each of 4 classes for each Class is paid out in cash. Remainder divided Lewis Class; 1 class for each 3 shooters. Best 6 of 10 scores to count for all prizes. ALL SHOOTERS ARE ELIGIBLE FOR CLASS SHOOT OFF. All prizes will be paid out in cash. \$5.00 cash will be awarded to High Gun in each of four Lewis classes, divided equally depending on total number of shooters. \$1.00 of each entry will go into a number jackpot for each shoot, to be determined by the last number of the next evening's daily number.\$1.00 will go toward white bird payoff, for which a white bird will be thrown for each full squad.
