### \*\*\*\*\*\* 2025 Membership Renewal Information \*\*\*\*\*\*\*

Enclosed with this newsletter is your 2025 official membership renewal form. The membership renewal form will be sent out again with the winter newsletter and will also be available on the Club's website and in the Fisherman's cabin. Complete it and send it in today! The 2025 membership renewal period runs between September 1, 2024 and December 31, 2024. Do not mail your completed renewal application in before September 1, 2024.

#### ALL MEMBERSHIPS EXPIRE ON DECEMBER 31ST, 2024. DUES MUST BE PAID OR POST-MARKED NO LATER THAN DECEMBER 31ST, 2024. THERE ARE ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEP-TIONS. THE 2025 DUES ARE ONE HUNDERED FIFTY DOLLARS (\$150.00) USD.

Your completed membership renewal form for 2025, along with the completed and signed Waiver and Release of Liability form on the reverse side, can be mailed in after September 1, 2024, and must be postmarked on or before December 31, 2024. In addition, members can now drop off their 2025 membership renewals in person. A mail slot has been added to the door of the Fisherman's Cabin. Please note, that 2025 membership renewals are still required to be postmarked on or before December 31, 2024, or dropped in the new mail slot prior to midnight on December 31,2024. Any 2025 membership renewals found in the new mail slot after December 31, 2024 will be considered late and returned. No Exceptions.

Dependent members wanting to procure their own membership must attend the monthly General Membership Meeting on Tuesday, January 21st, 2025 @ 7:30pm. They must bring a completed Dependent Membership Application, SHGFFA liability release form, proof of graduation, ID and \$150.00 USD. #### Game Committee

The Pennsylvania Game Commission has outlawed the use of buckshot statewide, in keeping with our "no single projectile rule", deer hunting on the Club grounds will now be limited to archery hunting only. Bows and crossbows may be used on Club grounds for firearms deer seasons. Hunting with shotguns on Club grounds will continue to be allowed for small game.

In addition to PA Game regulations, the following rules apply when hunting on Club grounds:

- No single projectiles while hunting with firearms on Club grounds, hunting is limited to shotguns and archery equipment.
- Hunters must wear a fluorescent orange hat for all hunting on Club grounds; this is in addition to any fluorescent orange required by PA Game laws.
- Tree stands may not be left on Club property, and must be carried in and out each day. Hunters using tree stands are required to wear a full body harness while on Club property.
- No baiting allowed on Club property.


Please hunt safely, and respect safety zones while on Club property. Thanks, Kevin
