Be sure to purchase your 2025 PA fishing license, along with a trout stamp, before opening day on April 5th..

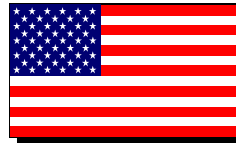

*** 2025 Opening Day of Trout Season Information ***

2025 Opening Day of Trout - April 5th at 8:00am

February 18th - Fishing at the Club will be closed after this date and will resume on opening day of trout beginning on April 5th at 8:00am. Purchase your 2025 PA fishing license with a trout stamp prior to opening day

April 3rd - We will stock 2,300 ~ 13- 14 inch rainbow trout.

April 4th - We will stock 2,300 ~ 13- 14 inch & 25 ~ 20- 26 inch rainbow trout.

April 5th - **OPENING DAY OF TROUT SEASON** ~ 8:00am.

April 11th - We will stock 4,000 ~ 13 - 14 inch & 25 ~ 20- 26 inch rainbow trout. (No fishing until 6:00am on April 13th).

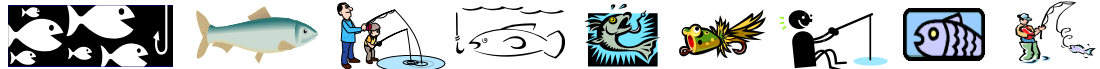
April 18th - for Kid's Day - we will stock 600 ~13- 14 & 12 ~ 15- 17 inch rainbow trout in the kid's pond, pickerel pond, and catch and release pond. These ponds will be off- limits to all members until April 20th at 8:00am.

April 19th - **Kid's Day**-open to kids 12 years of age and under. Begins at 8:00am. Only one (1) rod can be used. The parent or guardian can throw the line in, but the kid must reel the fish in by themselves. There will be prizes, along with hotdogs and drinks this year.

April 20th - Members can fish in the kid's, pickerel, and catch and release ponds after 6:00am.



ALL GUN RANGES and the ARCHERY RANGE WILL BE CLOSED FIRST TWO WEEKENDS OF TROUT SEASON - April 5th, April 6th, April 12th, April 13th & Kid's Day on April 19th



Members of the Board of Directors will man strategic check points the first two weekends of trout season verifying everyone's Club membership. You must have in your possession the following:

- 1). **2025 Club membership badge**
- 2). **2025 PA fishing license with trout stamp**
- 3). **A valid photo ID**

Anyone caught attempting to bring in a non- member to fish will immediately lose their membership in the Club. No Exceptions.

We are currently shooting indoor bulls-eye and will start outdoor Wednesday night shooting April. Wednesday night outdoor shooting pistol is open to all, but you must take a safety check (new shooters) and non-members must sign a release, along with paying a fee. Please clean up after yourself, pick up empty shell cases and place them in buckets. Pick up mis-fires and place them in the orange bucket. Pull staples and put target stands back. Do not shoot in front of benches. Do not use the saw horses to hold targets. Be courteous to others and report any unsafe or bad actions to any Director. This is your Club, keep it safe and remember the cameras are operational 24-7. Thanks, Neil
